1. ____ The hands are considered part of the bat.
2. ____ The batter-runner must turn to his right after over-running first base.
3. ____ If the batter breaks his wrists when swinging, it's a strike.
4. ____ If a batted ball hits the plate first it's a foul ball.
5. ____ The batter cannot be called out for interference if he is in the batter's box.
6. ____ The ball is dead on a foul-tip.
7. ____ The batter may not switch from one batters box to another after two strikes.
8. ____ The batter who batted out of order is the person declared out.
9. ____ The batter may not overrun first base when he gets a base-on-balls
10. ____ The batter is out if he starts for the dugout before going to first after a dropped third strike.
11. ____ If the batter does not pull the bat out of the strike zone while in the bunting position, it's an automatic strike.
12. ____ The batter is out if a bunted ball hits the ground and bounces back up and hits the bat while the batter is holding the bat
13. ____ The batter is out if his foot touches the base before the throw.
14. ____ The batter-runner is always out if he runs outside the running lane after a bunted ball.
15. ____ A runner is out if he slaps hands or high-fives other players, after a homerun is hit over the fence.
16. ____ Tie goes to the runner.
17. ____ The runner gets the base he's going to, plus one, on a ball thrown out-of-play.
18. ____ Anytime a coach touches a runner, the runner is out.

21. _____ The runner is always safe when hit by a batted ball while touching a base.

25. _____ A runner is out if he runs out of the baseline to avoid a fielder who is fielding a batted ball.
26. _____ Runners may not advance when an infield fly is called.
27. _____ No run can score when a runner is called out for the third out for not tagging up.

29. _____ The batter does not get first base if hit by a pitch after it bounces.
