

13. ___ R1 and no outs. BR hits a slow roller to third. His throw to second is in time for the out, but BR is already past first before F4's throw leaves his hand. F4's throw goes into the dug out. Put BR on third.

14. ___ F1 in contact with the rubber throws his pick off attempt into the first base dug out. Put R1 on second.

15. ___ F1 steps back from the rubber and throws his pick off attempt into the stands. Put R1 on third.

16. ___ F1 pitches ball four into the dirt, off the catcher's shin guards and through a hole in the backstop. Put the batter on second.

17. ___ F1 pitches ball four past the catcher. BR sprints to first and rounds the bag in time to see the catcher attempt to keep the ball in play by deflecting it with his shinguards. However, he kicks it into the dug out. Put R1 on second.

18. ___ If a play is being made on an obstructed runner, that runner will be awarded at least one base beyond the last base legally touched.

19. ___ R2 is nearly picked off and subsequently gets in a rundown. He is obstructed by F4 as he attempts to get back to second. Award R2 third base.

20. ___ If no play is being made on an obstructed runner, play will proceed until no further action is possible.

21. ___ R2 attempts to score on a bloop single to left. He slightly bumps into F5 who is standing three feet in front of third watching F7 picking up the ball. The base coach waves him on after hearing the ump signal obstruction. F7's throw retires R2 on a banger at the plate. The out is good because the contact was slight and the umpire correctly judged R2 would not have scored anyway.

22. ___ Same play as in #21 only R2 is out by thirty feet. The out is good.

23. ___ The squeeze is on. The catcher jumps in front of the plate, catches the pitch, and tags out R3. Put BR on first and score the run.

24. ___ One out. The squeeze is on. The pitcher steps back off the rubber and throws home. The batter lays down a perfect bunt and beats it out. Inning is over.

25. ___ To avoid being hit, R2 hesitates in front of F6 about to field a grounder. F6 boots the ball. Intentional or not, call out R2. Put BR on first.

26. ___ R1 is stealing as BR foul tips into the catcher's mitt. The defense appeals that R1 didn't tag up. Appeal denied.
